Website Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

• 1.1 We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our website visitors; in this policy we explain how we will treat your personal information. As a user of our website your privacy is important to us. We are dedicated to safeguarding your personal and financial information. We restrict access to confidential personal information about you to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to comply with federal standards to guard your confidential personal information.

2. Collecting personal information

- 2.1 We may collect, store and use the following kinds of personal information:
 - (a) information about your computer and about your visits to and use of this website (including your IP address, geographical location, browser type and version, operating system, referral source, length of visit, page views and website navigation path);
 - (b) information that you provide to us when registering with our website (including your email address);

3. Using your personal information

- **3.1** Personal information submitted to us through our website will be used for the purposes specified in this policy or on the relevant pages of the website.
- **3.2** We may use your personal information to:

 publish and otherwise use that information in accordance with the license you
 grant to us.
- 3.4 We will not, without your express consent, supply your personal
 information to any third party for the purpose of their or any other third party's
 direct marketing.

4. Disclosing personal information

- **4.1** We may disclose your personal information to any of our employees, officers, insurers, professional advisers, agents, suppliers or subcontractors insofar as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this policy or to complete the services you have agreed to have us perform.
- 4.2 We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group of affiliated member companies (this means our subsidiaries, or other affiliated member companies) insofar as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out

in this policy or to complete the services you have agreed to have us perform. These affiliated companies will adhere to the provisions of this Privacy Policy and shall keep your information confidential in a similar or same fashion as set out herein.

- **4.3** We may disclose your personal information:
 - o (a) to the extent that we are required to do so by law;
 - (b) in connection with any ongoing or prospective legal proceedings;
 - (c) in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk); and
 - o (d) to provide the services you have agreed to have us perform.
- **4.4** Except as provided in this policy, we will not provide your personal information to third parties without your prior consent.

5. Retaining personal information

- **5.1** This Section 5 sets out our data retention policies and procedure, which are designed to help ensure that we comply with our legal obligations in relation to the retention and deletion of personal information.
- **5.2** Personal information that we process for any purpose or purposes shall not be kept for no longer than is necessary for that purpose or those purposes.
- **5.3** Notwithstanding the other provisions of this Section 5, we will retain documents (including electronic documents) containing personal data:
 - o (a) to the extent that we are required to do so by law;
 - (b) if we believe that the documents may be relevant to any ongoing or prospective legal proceedings; and
 - (c) in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk).
 - o (d) to provide the services you have agreed to have us perform

6. Security of your personal information

- **6.1** We will take reasonable technical and organizational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information.
- **6.2** We will store all the personal information you provide on our secure (password- and firewall-protected) servers.
- 6.3 You acknowledge that the transmission of information over the internet is inherently insecure, and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet.

8. Your rights
